



ATCoin Holder

Supplies needed: (1) 3.5 x 7.75" heavy weight cardstock cover, (1) 12 x 2.75" strip for the spine, (6) 3.5 x 6.5" strips for pocket pages, 1 yd. coordinating ribbon, (4) 3.25 x 3.25" and (2) 3.25 x 0.5" decorative panel pieces, (6) 2.5" circles and (6) 2.75" squares of acetate.


Step 1. Score the 3.5 x 7.75" strip horizontally at 3.5 and 4.25". Fold on score lines and crease with a bone folder to create the book cover. Add a line of adhesive horizontally across the center of the outside of the cover. Fold the ribbon in half and center it across the adhesive pressing firmly to adhere. Nest the decorative panel pieces on the inside and outside of the cover and attach with adhesive.




Step 2. Score the 12 x 2.75" strip at 1 inch intervals and accordion fold. Set aside.




Step 3. Score the 3.5 x 6.5" pocket strips horizontally at 3" and 6". Turn the strip vertically and score at 3". Trim according to the diagram below and fold on the score lines. Crease with a bone folder. Punch a 2.5" circle in the center of the piece with the tabs and set aside. Flip the strip over and add adhesive to the side with the circle cutout and adhere a piece of acetate. Fold the tabs toward the circle cutout and add adhesive to each. Fold the remaining flap to create a pocket and press firmly to adhere.




Step 4. Trim away the first 1" fold from the left side of the spine piece.




Align your accordion fold using the diagram below. Starting on the right side of the strip, add adhesive to each right valley fold.



Center the pocket on the strip with the opening to the top and cutout facing up. Press firmly to adhere. Continue attaching pockets, folding and aligning with the previous pocket to form a stack.



Add adhesive to the back of the last pocket. Center on the inside back cover and adhere firmly.



Gently pull the top pocket to the left and your pockets should cascade out so that each ATCoin can be viewed. (You can attach a ribbon pull to the left side of the top pocket to make this easier.)

Step 5. Decorate the ATCoins and insert in the pockets!
